## The Debian testing distribution: insecure by design

- dependency hell
- unrelated release critical bugs can block security fixes

- built in "testing" delays
- autobuilder lag
- based on unstable, which has no security team

#### How Debian developers can help

- include CVE ids in changeogs and bug reports
- get CVE ids asigned for security holes that lack ids
- don't hide security fixes
- respond quickly to security bugs (or be NMUed)

## A rough comparison of stable and testing

112 DSAs issued between January and May 2005

- ▶ 56 (50%) fixed in stable first
- 37 (33%) fixed in testing first
- ▶ 19 (17%) did not affect testing
- XXX (XX%) affected stable with DSA
