# Official images: “Debian”?

An official Debian image should...

Respect Debian’s Social Contract.

- Comply with the DFSG
- Focus on users’ needs

# Official images: “Debian”?

An official Debian image should...

Use Debian as its trust anchor.

- Packages and repositories
- Image builds and discovery
- Security fixes and updates



# Official images: “Debian”?

An official Debian image should...

Be developed within Debian

- Build tool maintenance
- Debian lists, IRC, etc
- Where should code live?

- Wiki, BTS, etc

\* This is a big gap! We need to be able to QA cloud images!

# Official images: Public clouds

Unique concerns in the public cloud context

*Clouds don't release every 2 years*

- Quick fixes needed: performance, security
  - Paying customers complain to cloud vendor
  - Upstream fix can take time
  - *Google examples: irqbalance, kernel vulnerabilities*

# Official images: Public clouds

Unique concerns in the public cloud context

*Clouds don't release every 2 years*

- Customers expect smooth integration
  - OS changes required for integration
- Google examples:
  - API improvements every couple months
  - Account and SSH key management
  - Networking support
